

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are continuing our theme of 'Roman Britain' this half term and we will be linking this to our English and DT.

**History** – We will be finding out more about the Romans and life in Roman Britain.

**Geography** – We will be thinking about living sustainably, what we can do and what other people around the world are doing and the positive impact on the environment.

**Art** – We will be using different media (charcoal, watercolour paint for example) to tell stories through drawing.

**English** – We will be describing settings and characters and writing instructions. The main books we will use this half term are 'Escape from Pompeii' and 'Weslandia' and 'Pompeii' for our class reading.

**Grammar, punctuation, handwriting and spelling:** Each week we will also have grammar and punctuation, handwriting and spelling sessions. Some handwriting and spelling sessions will link with the words the children bring home to practise spelling.

### **Maths**

**Area and perimeter:** We will be making and comparing the area of shapes using squares, using metres and kilometres to measure and compare, and finding the perimeter of shapes.

**Column addition and subtraction:** We will be developing our skills, both for written, column methods and for simplifying calculations in order to use mental methods.

**Multiplication and division:** We will be multiplying and dividing by 3, 4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, 12, 1 and 0 and using multiplication to help us answer questions about division. We will also be multiplying 3 numbers together and solving word problems.

**Times tables:** We are practising these every week in school and would be grateful if you could encourage and support your child(ren) to practise these at home too.

**Religious Education (RE)** – We will be finding out about Jewish festivals.

**Science** – We will be learning about teeth and the human digestive system and linking this to what we already know about nutrition. We will also be comparing the teeth of carnivores, omnivores and herbivores.

**Spanish** – We will be developing our vocabulary for colour words and classroom commands and instructions and learning how to describe places around a town, asking 'Where is?' and being able to answer.

**Personal, Social, Health and Moral Education (PSHME)** – We will be exploring families and friendships.

**ICT** – We will be exploring recording sound and making podcasts.

**Music** – We will be continuing with our ukulele lessons and doing lots of singing this half term in readiness for our Christmas performance.

**DT** – We will be making, tasting and evaluating our own versions of Minestrone soup.
