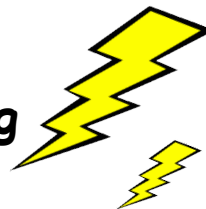


Year 5 Autumn 1 Home Learning

Ancient Greece



Year 5, here are some ideas for home learning projects for Autumn 1 about the Ancient Greeks.

Dress up as an Ancient Greek- rich, poor, or even a soldier or mythical monster. Take a photo, and then explain your costume, labelling each item of clothing.

Draw/paint a picture of something from Ancient Greece e.g. a Greek banquet, or the Olympics. Write an explanation of what is happening in your picture.

Use Power Point to **create a presentation** to teach younger children about the Ancient Greeks.

Research the **Greek Gods** and their family trees.

Create a model of your own Greek hero, monster or God.



Create a 3D model Of an Ancient Greek landmark. Write an explanation about what it is or a set of instructions to explain how you made it.

Design and make a Spartan shield. Find out why the Spartans were such good warriors.

Write a secret message using the **Greek alphabet** (with an alphabet key).

Make your own Clepsydra (Ancient Greek water clock)

Research the differences between Athens and Sparta.
