Clubs, Boosters and Tuition started again. Please check out our extensive list of Sportacus clubs and consider signing your child up for these extra-curricular activities.

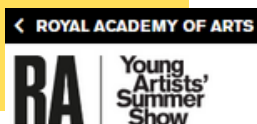
Before the Winter Break we gathered money for Crisis at Christmas. We are delighted to tell you that £377.85 was raised. Thank you for your generosity.

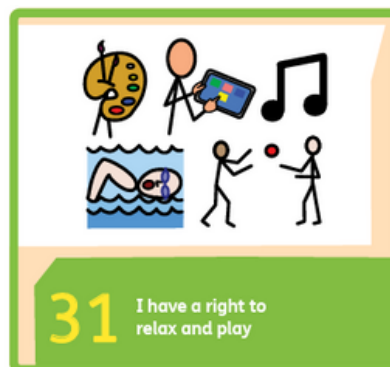

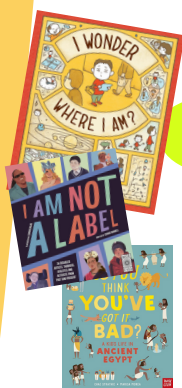
